



College of Electrical Training 2018 VET in School Program Information

College of Electrical Training (CET) is now seeking *expressions of interest* from candidates for the **CET 2018 Certificate II Electrotechnology Pre-Apprenticeship In School Program**. DTWD have not yet approved funding and until funding has been approved, there is no guarantee that the course will run.

To be considered all candidates must set up an account and register for the Readiness Assessment at www.energyspace.com.au. The scheduled Readiness Assessment (RA) sessions for both the Joondalup and Jandakot Campus will be run on the 7th, 10th, 14th and 17th August 2017, however alternative dates can be negotiated if required. As this is a critical factor in the selection process, please ensure that any students who apply discuss the contents of the Readiness Assessment with their Maths teacher, *particularly if they have not yet covered Trigonometry*.

The RA assessments will be hosted at CET Joondalup, 20 Injune Way, Joondalup, and CET Jandakot, 5 Avior Avenue, Jandakot or alternatively, can be undertaken at the student's school in an invigilated session. Schools that choose this option will need to contact CET on the day of the assessment so that the daily session password can be provided. A non-programmable scientific calculator, pen/pencil and working paper are only to be provided/allowed. The schools will need to provide their own invigilator and internet access.

After the Readiness Assessment results are reviewed, selected candidates will then be asked to attend an interview with the Training Manager, and final positions will be offered to the most suitable candidates.

There will be an Information Evening for successful students, parents/guardians and VET Coordinators held at the College prior to the commencement of training. This will be the opportunity to tour the premises and ask any questions and collect any required text books.

At our Joondalup campus the course is run Wednesdays during term, with an occasional block release. (Subject to confirmation)

At our Jandakot campus it is intended to run two streams, stream one which will attend two days a week (Thursday & Friday) during school terms and stream two that will attend one day a week (Thursday) during school term with a five day block release prior to school term 1 starting.

162 hours of work experience is mandatory for the qualification, and we expect that students/schools will arrange host employers for work experience. Stream one will need to complete work experience in school term 3 on Thursday's and Friday's rather than attend CET. Stream two will need to complete work experience in school holidays or days other than Thursday's throughout the school year.

It is best to explain to parents that students that fail to undertake the required amount of work experience will result in the student NOT completing the qualification.

Note: All work experience hours must be completed before a Certificate can be issued for WACE purposes.
