Mandurah Catholic College is a K - 12, Catholic co-educational day school, established in 1992, with approximately 1650 students enrolled in 2017. The inspiration for the foundation of the College came from Bishop Quinn, the Bishop of Bunbury. It was his vision, coupled with immense support from the Mandurah Catholic community that saw the initial transformation of this site of natural Australian bush land into the beautiful and growing school we have today. The College is located on a picturesque, bush-covered 12 hectare site approximately 2 kilometres from the centre of Mandurah.

The crest of the College is a cross within a circle. The cross symbolises the sacrifice that we, as Christians, must make to ensure that we leave this world a better place, while the circle symbolises the eternal and all encompassing nature of our God. The motto, "Seek Truth", comes directly from the aims of the College. There is always a need to seek, and the word itself implies effort and willingness to work according to one's capacity. Truth is the object of all discovery, implying a search for an ideal, and never being satisfied with mediocrity. The ultimate truth is God, who is the object of our seeking.

Mandurah Catholic College, as a Catholic School, is a Christian community and seeks to provide an environment supportive of the development of Catholic values, attitudes, beliefs and practices. It is a place where the young will encounter people of faith who show that they care deeply for the individual and are willing to share their own experience of faith.

# SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

## Important Details

1. The College Board will award an academic scholarship to a student entering Year 7 and Year 11 in 2018, who excels academically. Remission of 100% of tuition fee will be awarded. Camp and sundry charges are payable by the parent.
2. Scholarship Examination results are used to determine the successful candidate, in conjunction with an interview. Candidates who proceed to the interview stage will be asked to provide copies of recent school reports and character references.
3. The Academic Scholarship is tenable for three years ie, Years 7, 8 and 9 or Years 10, 11 and 12.
4. Please note the Academic Scholarship is contingent upon exemplary levels of involvement, performance and behaviour by the awarded student while at the College and will be reviewed yearly.


## Important Dates
