The following terms and conditions are to apply with regard to application for and acceptance of the Scholarship/s:

- ii) Applicants must be supportive of the Catholic ethos of the College.
- iii) Applicants are to be demonstrably committed to schooling.
- iv) Scholarships are tenable for duration of enrolment; however, failure to meet satisfactory standards of achievement may result in the Scholarship being withdrawn.
- v) Successful application does in no way bind the College to granting the Scholarship to younger siblings in later years. It is to be noted that younger siblings enrolled at the College receive normal family discounts.
- vi) Failure of the successful applicant or his/her parents to adhere to the conditions of enrolment; ie, ensuring the student wears the full school uniform, upholding the published rules of the College, supporting the Catholic philosophy of the College, and participating in College activities, may result in the Scholarship being withdrawn.
