## Dress Code Standards and Policies

### Years 5 - 12 WINTER UNIFORM Terms 2 & 3

Hair to be clean, neat and off the face. If longer than the collar, hair must be tied back with College or natural coloured hair accessories.



College blazer is compulsory for Secondary students only, to be worn to school, from school and out of school if in winter uniform. To be worn at all formal occasions.

**Primary students are not required to wear the College blazer.**

College white shirt with College crest (optional short or long sleeves). Top button to be done up to the collar. College tartan tie, knot to be taut, straight and meet the collar.

Trousers to be worn at waist height. A plain black leather belt with a plain silver buckle may be worn if required.

Grey socks with College bands.

Skirt to be at the knee and not rolled at the waist.

College jumper - Optional



Black, lace-up polished shoes with low heels.



Hair to be clean, neat and off the face. If longer than the collar, hair must be tied back with College or natural coloured hair accessories.



Girls may wear College grey trousers (as an alternative to the skirt), with College white socks with College bands.

College grey tights without holes or runs. Tights must be purchased from the Uniform Shop.

**Primary students may wear College white socks with College bands.**
