The College of Electrical Training (CET) is now seeking *expressions of interest* from candidates for the **2021 Certificate II Electrotechnology Pre-Apprenticeship In School Program** and a **2020 Certificate II Electrotechnology Pre-Apprenticeship In School Program**.

October 2020 Certificate II Electrotechnology Pre-Apprenticeship In School Program

The Jandakot campus will be commencing a fully funded Certificate II pre-apprenticeship class on the 14th October 2020 which will continue through terms one to three in 2021.

This course will run one day a week on a **Wednesday** during school terms. To be considered for this intake all students must be recognised as being in year 11 at the start of the program.

2021 Certificate II Electrotechnology Pre-Apprenticeship In School Program

The Jandakot campus is now also seeking *expressions of interest* from candidates for the CET 2021 Certificate II Electrotechnology Pre-Apprenticeship In School Program. These classes will be conducted on a **Thursday** or **Friday** (DTWD have not yet approved funding and until funding has been approved, there is no guarantee that the course will run).

Candidates for either intake will need to contact Katherine Fearn, katherine.fearn@cet.asn.au at the Jandakot campus to book in for one of the available Readiness Assessment time slots and nominate which intake they wish to apply for. Please note that spaces are limited for Readiness Assessments conducted at the campus.

The Readiness Assessments will be hosted at the College of Electrical Training, Jandakot Campus, 5 Avior Avenue, Jandakot or alternatively, can be undertaken at the student's school in an invigilated session. Schools that choose this option will need to contact CET on the day of the RA so that the daily session password can be provided. A non-programmable scientific calculator, pen/pencil and working paper are only to be provided/allowed. The schools will need to provide their own invigilator and internet access.

The scheduled Readiness Assessment sessions for the Jandakot Campus are currently going to take place at **8am** and **1pm** on:

- ▶ Thursday July 23rd
- ▶ Tuesday July 28th
- ▶ Wednesday July 29th
- ▶ Thursday July 30th
- ▶ August 3rd to 7th Monday to Friday

As this is a critical factor in the selection process, please ensure that any students who apply discuss the contents of the Readiness Assessment with their Maths teacher, *particularly if they have not yet covered Trigonometry.*

After the Readiness Assessment results are reviewed, selected candidates will then be invited to take part in an interview (this may be a phone or face to face interview) and final positions will be offered to the most suitable candidates.

There will be an Information Evening for successful students, parents/guardians and VET Coordinators held at the College prior to the commencement of training. This will be the opportunity to tour the premises and ask any questions and collect any further information.

Work experience is mandatory for the qualification, and CET will work with students/ schools to arrange host employers for work experience and complete any required paperwork.

Students that fail to undertake the required amount of work experience will result in the student NOT completing the qualification.

Note: All work experience hours must be completed before a Certificate can be issued for WACE purposes.
