TLC110 – Learning for Tomorrow Application Information 2021

Dear Applicant,

We are pleased to confirm that Murdoch University will offer *TLC110; Learning for Tomorrow* in 2021 at the Rockingham and Mandurah campuses.

There are some changes to the application process with DIRECT ONLINE applications being invited from this time. Applicants should upload the **Statement of Validation** in conjunction with their application, although no personal statement is needed.

To gain entry to Murdoch University via the TLC110 – Learning for Tomorrow pathway a student must:

- achieve WACE,
- successfully complete and pass TLC110 (this includes meeting the attendance requirement),
- demonstrate English Language Competence (ELC)*
- be verified as ready for study in TLC110 by the School Coordinator

Year 11 students from Murdoch University partner schools who meet the following criteria are encouraged to apply. To be eligible for TLC110 - Learning for Tomorrow you must be:

- enrolled in a year 12 program at an invited school within Rockingham, Kwinana or Peel AND
- undertaking 3 or less ATAR-level units AND
- undertaking ATAR English or General English*.

* TLC110 students must demonstrate English Language Competency (ELC) in addition to successfully completing TLC110, in order to be eligible for direct entry to Murdoch University.

Applications for 2021 must be completed via the link on the [TLC110: Learning for tomorrow webpage](#). Instructions on how to apply can be found on the webpage.

Please note: when completing an application, you need to select the TLC110 Learning for Tomorrow course code which is **N1070 Headstart**

Applications close **30 November 2020. NO LATE APPLICATIONS CAN BE ACCEPTED.**

Students need to accept their offer to complete the enrolment process. After acceptance they will be sent a survey to record their class attendance preferences. Schools will be notified after classes have been finalised.
